

## Please...

- Wear a **mask**/face covering
- Come to the **back of** the practice – see below
- Do not just turn up
- **Go to the toilet** before coming – patient toilets are closed
- **Come alone \***
- Anyone coming must answer covid **screening questions**
- If your answers to covid screening questions alter please phone to cancel – do not turn up
- Bring along
  - a completed signed dated **medical history form** (do NOT email it)
  - **list of drugs** if you take any
  - (**mobile phone** if you have one)
  - **debit/credit card** if you may need to pay for something (not cash if at all possible)
  - **umbrella** if it might rain (though we have built a shelter for your comfort)
- Please **do not bring along anything you do not need** but be aware the windows will be open so it may be colder than usual
- Please arrive **on time**, not early or late, to the rear of the practice
- Please do not knock on/wait in front of the door, **wait in yellow painted spaces**
- A member of staff will invite you in at your appointment time
- Keep **2 metres** apart from other people as much as possible including as you walk into the practice

\* If a **carer/parent** is needed only one extra can come who must follow all the covid safety points above— questions, mask etc. If appointment is for **one child** only bring that child

## Directions

This is the temporary entrance for us (and Paul, upper floors are using the front door on Cumberland St)

Sorry but there is **NO parking** in the practice car park, it is staff only and must be kept clear. Tell us in advance if you have mobility issues or problems standing

There are signs on the wall. A wooden gate is to its right – see photo above. Walk to **back** of car park and **turn left** to see where to stand, there is a covered shelter.
