Caring for you and your smile

- Please continue to wear a **mask**/face covering, this is still a requirement for healthcare settings
- You **can now choose** to come to the **front** of the building at 156 Cumberland Street if you so wish and let yourself in and out (please use handgel)  
**OR** to the **back**, if so please do not arrive too early, wait under the shelter at the rear of the car park and staff will let you in at your appointment time (For directions to the back of the practice see below)
- Patient toilets are still (mostly) closed
- **Come alone** if possible to allow for as much social distancing as possible\*
- We are still contacting everyone before their appointments with **covid screening questions**
- If your answers to these questions alter please phone to cancel, do not turn up
- Please do not bring along anything you do not need but be aware the **windows will be open** so it may be colder than usual

\* If a **carer/parent** is needed only one extra person can come who must follow all the covid safety points above—questions, mask etc. If appointment is for **one child** please only bring that child

**Directions** to the back of the building (if needed, **or come to the front** opposite Sainsburys and next to Footprints nursery)

Sorry but there is **NO parking** in the practice car park except in exceptional circumstances, it is staff only and must be kept clear.

Please tell us in advance if you have **mobility issues** or problems standing and we will do our best to let you use the easiest entrance for your needs

### From front of practice ...

#### The walk to Riseley St SK10 1BW



From Sainsburys carry on to right past the practice and **turn left onto Riseley Street** (just before the pelican crossing)...

### STAFF ONLY car park – with signs

#### The rear entrance from Riseley Street



... **Entrance** is on the **left**, **NOT** the **1st car park** on Riseley Street, it **IS** the **2<sup>nd</sup> car park set back** (between Oakleigh House, the Masons' building, and Riseley House). There are signs on the wall. A wooden gate is to its right – see photo above. Walk to **back** of car park and **turn left** to see where to stand, there is a covered shelter built specially to help keep you dry
